It generates most of its revenue through the sale of goods and services It has a defined social, cultural or environmental purpose

Embedded in its operation

Most profits are re-invested into purpose


51% or more of profits are reinvested into the social, cultural or environmental purpose with no, or limited, distribution to shareholders and owners

Social enterprises sell everything: chocolate and honey, corporate catering, junk removal, construction services, healthcare, family services, employment assistance, arts and culture, and much more. They compete with traditional forprofit businesses, but use their earnings to invest in vibrant, healthy communities.

Guidelines for Certification



We're excited that you are interested in joining our growing network of social enterprise leaders across Canada! Here's a step-by-step guide to the certification process.

1. Fill in the application

Fill in <u>this form</u> and tell us about your social enterprise including: your social, cultural or environmental purpose, what goods or services you sell, and how your business is incorporated. If you meet the social enterprise criteria for certification, we will set up an introductory meeting to get to know you and your social enterprise better.

2. Meet with us

3. Share your documents

We'll ask you to share your incorporation documents and financial documents to verify that your revenue comes from the sale of goods and services, and that the majority of your profits are reinvested into your social purpose.

4. Join the network

If you meet the social enterprise criteria from the documents provided, you will be added to the Buy Social Canada Certified Social Enterprise Directory and get access to other certification benefits.

Certification Fees

Certification is free for everyone for the first year.

Billing occurs on an annual basis each January, so you may get more than one year free!

After your first year, fees are based on your annual business revenue:

- Under \$500,000 \$100 per year
- Under \$1 million \$200 per year
- Above \$1 million \$300 per year
- Above \$15 million \$2,500 per year
